Coursework Transfer after Dismissal from the University

Statement

During the time a student is academically suspended or dismissed from EKU, course work earned at another regionally-accredited college or university will be considered for transfer credit when the student returns to EKU. Students are responsible for requesting that an official transcript of any transfer course work be sent to the EKU Office of Admissions when they apply for readmission to EKU. Students should consult with their advisor or college for the applicability of course work taken at another institution to their degree program at EKU.
