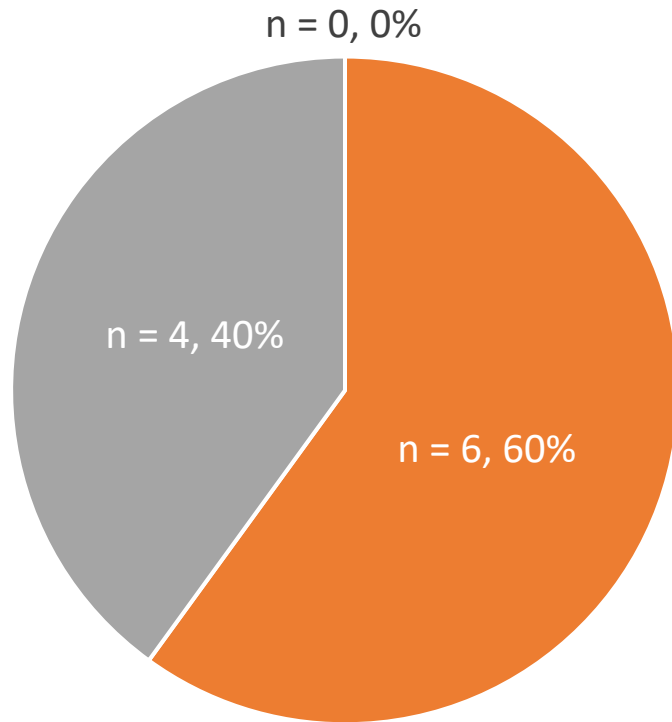

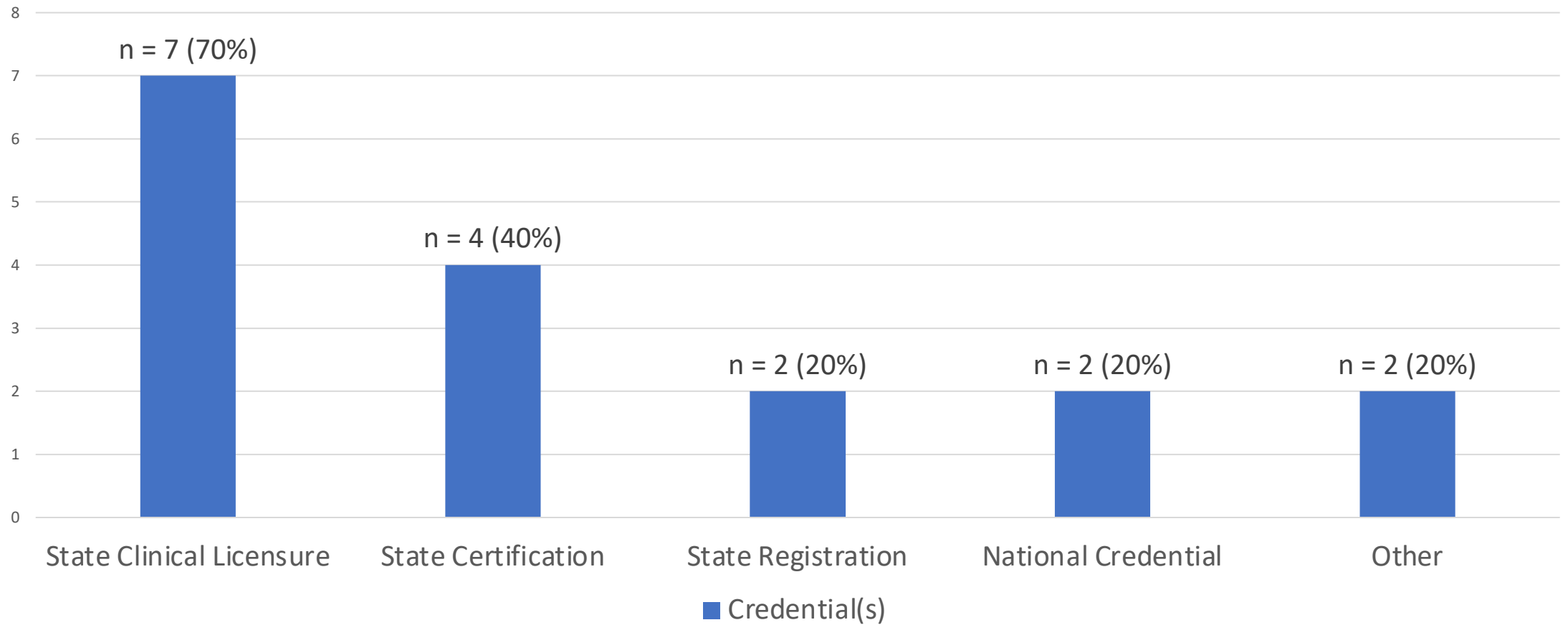

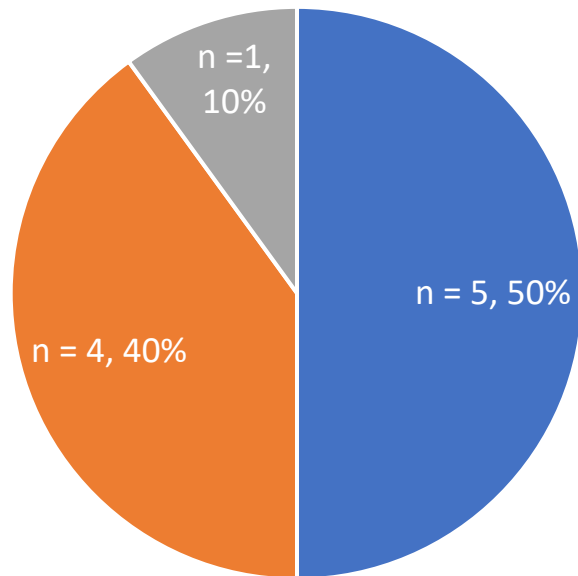

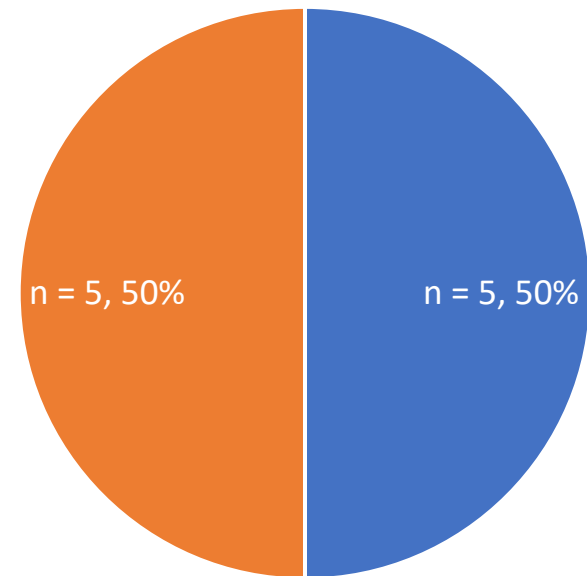

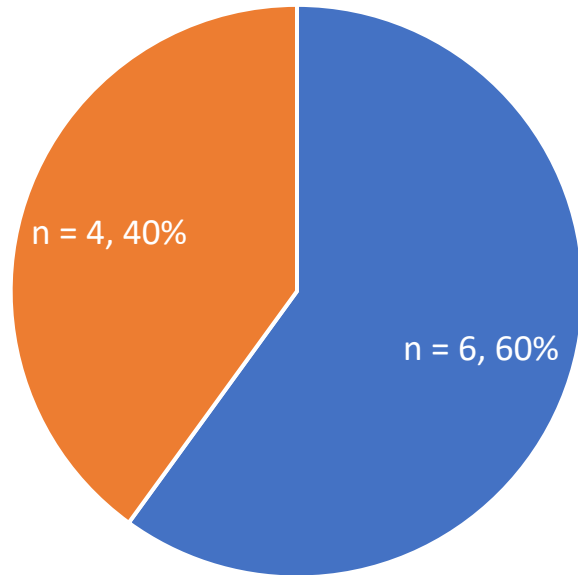
Knowledge and skills to be effective in a multicultural and diverse society

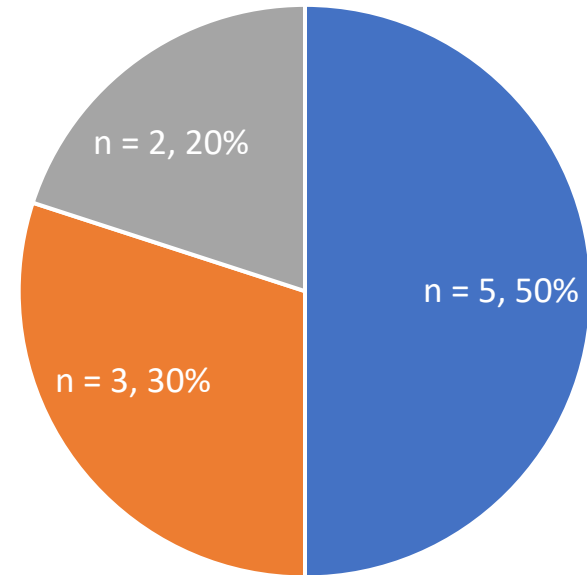

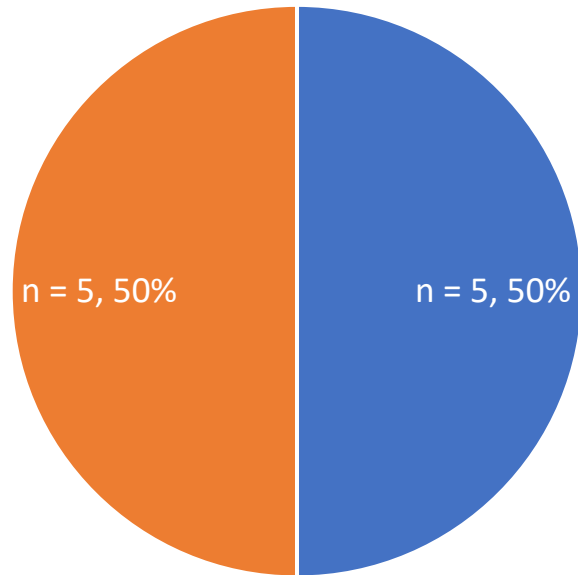

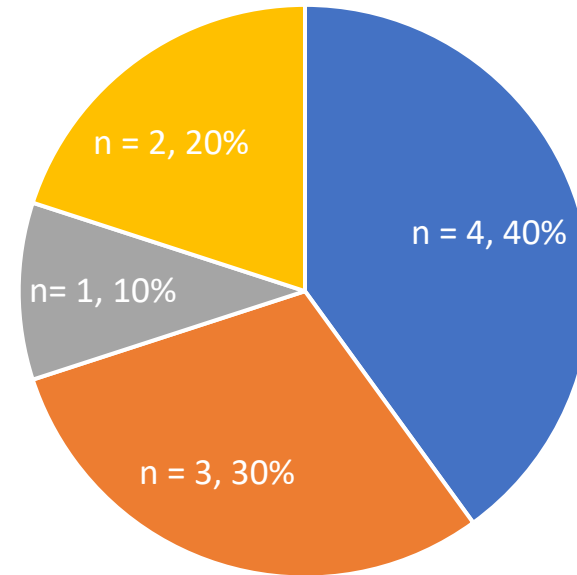

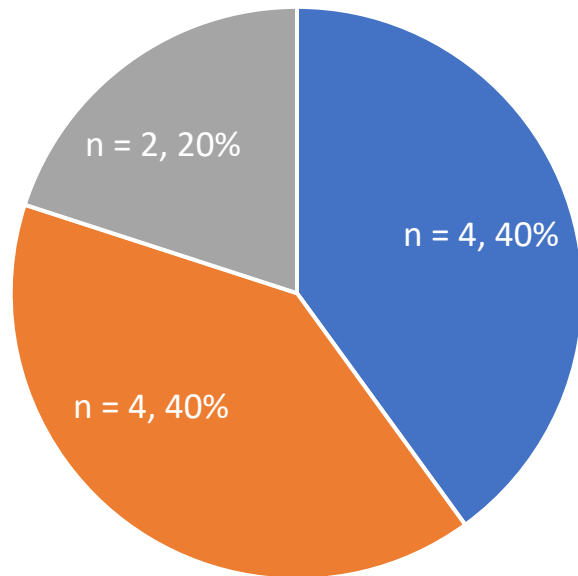

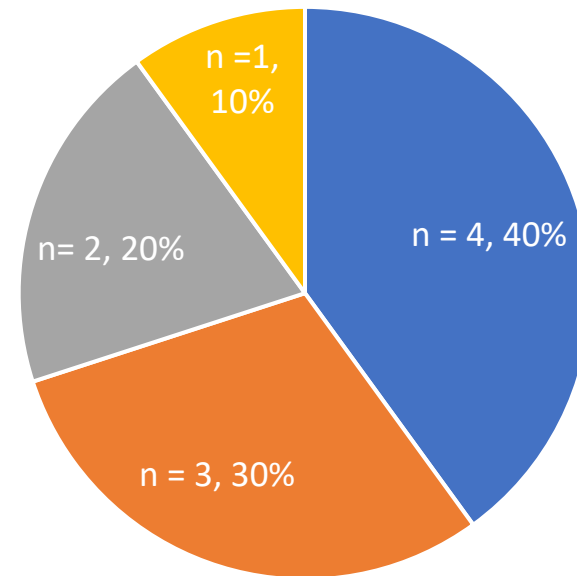

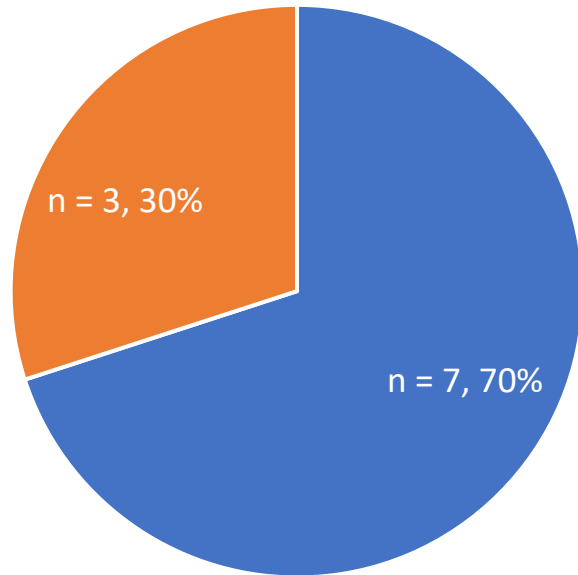

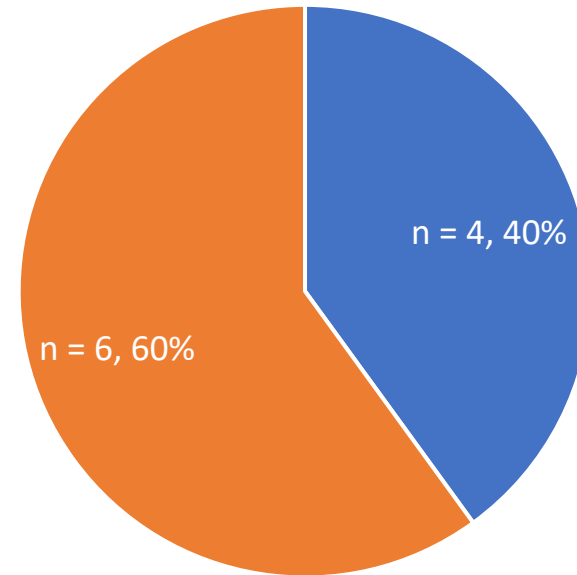

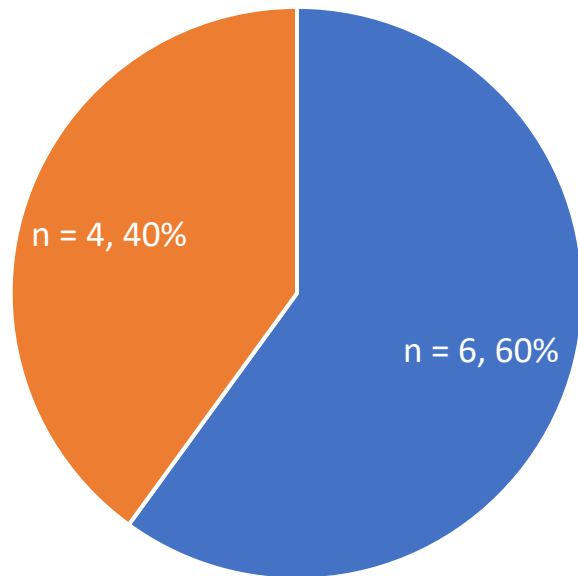
Potential for leadership skills and ability within current place of employment and/or the profession

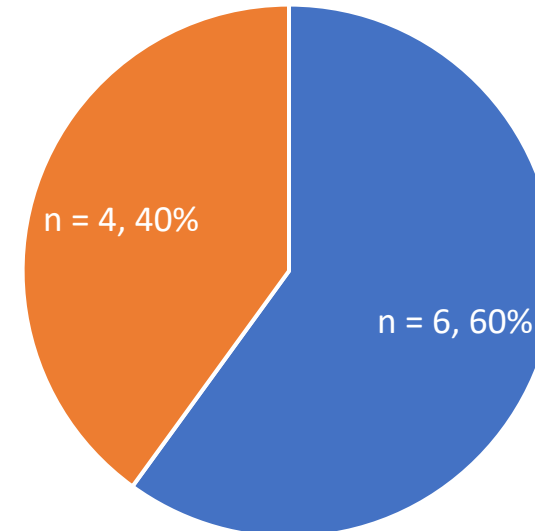

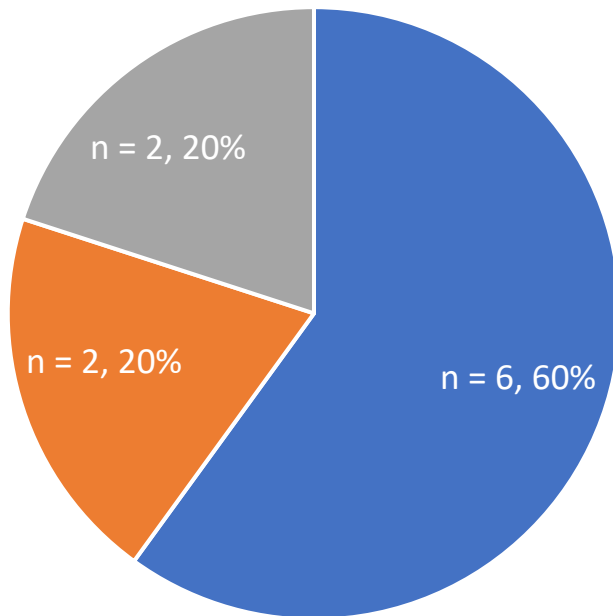

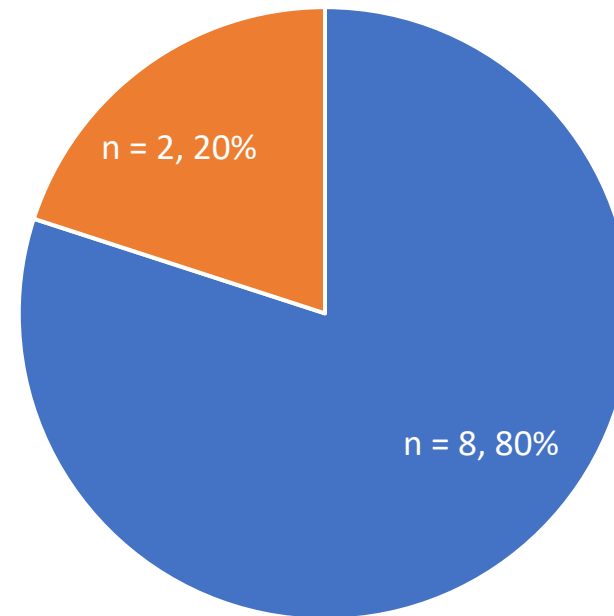
Hiring Graduates
