The Committee on Rules requests that the Faculty Senate adopt the following motion at its meeting on 5/1 /17.

MOTION: We propose that within the Faculty Handbook, Part Seven, Section VII. B. Membership of the Senate, 2) Elected Members, c), d)

2. Elected Members

c) All individuals eligible for election to the Faculty Senate, as well as Clinical Faculty and Lecturers, shall be eligible to vote in a Faculty Senate election. An individual shall be eligible to cast a ballot for Senate members only in that election unit in which the individual holds the academic rank of Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Instructor, Visiting Professor, Visiting Associate Professor, Visiting Assistant Professor, University Librarian, Associate University Librarian, Assistant University Librarian, Library Instructor, Clinical Faculty, or Lecturer.

d) Determination of Delegate Representation

Determination of delegate representation will include full-time faculty members as defined in Article II, Section B; Clinical Faculty; and Lecturers.

(1) An election unit with 1-14 faculty members during the Fall semester shall be entitled to one delegate for the academic year, and an election unit with 15-29 faculty members during the fall semester shall be entitled to two delegates for the academic year.

(2) An election unit with 30-39 faculty members during the Fall semester shall be entitled to three delegates for the academic year; an election unit with 40-49 faculty members during the Fall semester shall be entitled to four delegates for the academic year; an election unit with 50-59 faculty members during the Fall semester shall be entitled to five delegates for the academic year, and so on.

JUSTIFICATION: Ensures that all members of a department have representation on Faculty Senate.
